When primary school ends after seventh grade Ugandan children and their family are responsible for covering the full cost of any continuing education. Sister Schools accepts cash donations to assist children struggling to continue their studies at the high school level. The annual cost for a quality secondary education averages between \$750 for a day school to over \$2,000 for an exemplary boarding school. Full scholarship sponsors are still needed as well as general donations to the program. General scholarship donations will be applied towards tuition costs, room and board, school supplies, tutoring and medical checkups. Every dollar can make a difference and when we all give a little, children's lives in Uganda are changed forever.
